

1. Rationale:

The transition from Primary School to Secondary College can prove to be daunting for both students and parents. It is our responsibility to provide families with current information regarding secondary colleges in our network, creating an awareness of what each college has to offer students and to facilitate the enrolment of all Year 6 students in a secondary college.

2. Aims:

- To communicate information about secondary colleges to parents and students in Years 5 and 6.
- To communicate with Transition Coordinators from secondary colleges in our network to continue developing transitional activities for our Year 5 and 6 students.
- To ensure parents and students are given relevant information as to the transition process.
- To familiarise students with school routines they can expect in a secondary college.
- To organise the placement of Year 6 students to a secondary college for Year 7 as per the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development (DEECD).

3. Implementation:

- 3.1 A staff member will be appointed Transition Coordinator.
- 3.2 The Transition Coordinator to communicate with secondary schools, informing Year 5 & 6 students of information sessions and displaying flyers.
via the Year 5 & 6 Transition Noticeboard and in the School Newsletters.
- 3.3 A formal Year 6/7 Transition Information Session will be held at our school.
Parents/guardians of Year 6 students will receive Year 7 Application Forms in line with the North Western Victoria Region guidelines.
Region timeline late March – early April; usually due back by May.
- 3.4 Year 5 and 6 students and their parents will be encouraged to attend information sessions and tours held by secondary colleges.
- 3.5 Year 5 and 6 students will attend a variety of internal and external transition programs and activities in conjunction with local secondary colleges in our network.
- 3.6 Parents are notified of their students' secondary college placement by the Transition Coordinator at Greenvale Primary School; as per the North Western Victoria Region guidelines.
- 3.7 Students in Year 6 attend the official Orientation Day at their secondary college.

4. Evaluation:

- This policy will be reviewed as part of the school's ongoing policy and process review cycle.
- Relevant feedback will be sought from students, parents and teachers with regard to the transition process and activities.
