

YARRABEE YESTERDAY'S WORLD

YEAR 1 EXCURSION

Dear Parents/Guardians,

On **Wednesday 14th March and Thursday 15th March**, the Year 1 students are going to Yarrabee Yesterday's World. This term the children have been learning about History. Our topic covers a few of the following areas and questions:

1. **How life has changed over time**
2. **What has helped us improve life in our homes?**
3. **How has technology changed our lives?**
4. **Why do certain things change over time?**

At Yarrabee Yesterday's World, the children will have the opportunity to experience a day of life in the 1900's. In a country setting "Yarrabee" rural school and farmhouse enables children to understand the life of a country child at home and at school during this era. This will be a fantastic educational experience planned and conducted by primary educators.

The Year 1 cohort is large, so the organisers have recommended that we visit over two days. In order to do this, we had to split **1WM** to allow for even numbers.

On **Wednesday 14th March** students from **1WM, 1MO and 1DT** will visit Yarrabee Yesterday's World and on **Thursday 15th March** students from **1WM, 1ML and 1SC** will go to Yarrabee Yesterday's World.

We will leave school at approximately **9:30am** and return around **2:30pm**. Children will need to bring a packed lunch with recess (snack) and lunch in separate bags. Please ensure they have a drink bottle with water and a waterproof raincoat.
