Year 1 In-School Activity

Dear Parents/Guardians,

This term, part of the Year 1 Curiosity topic is ‘Power’. To support this unit of work we have organised an in-school activity from Hands-On Science. Students will each participate in a 90-minute session entitled “How Objects Move”. This session gives the students the opportunity to investigate the way objects move on land, through water and in the air. They will explore design technologies used in different modes of transport including size, shape, push and pull forces, and movement. From the incursion we intend to build on your child’s knowledge and vocabulary relating to Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM).
